#### 1. **Goal:** Create Young Readers: Early Literacy

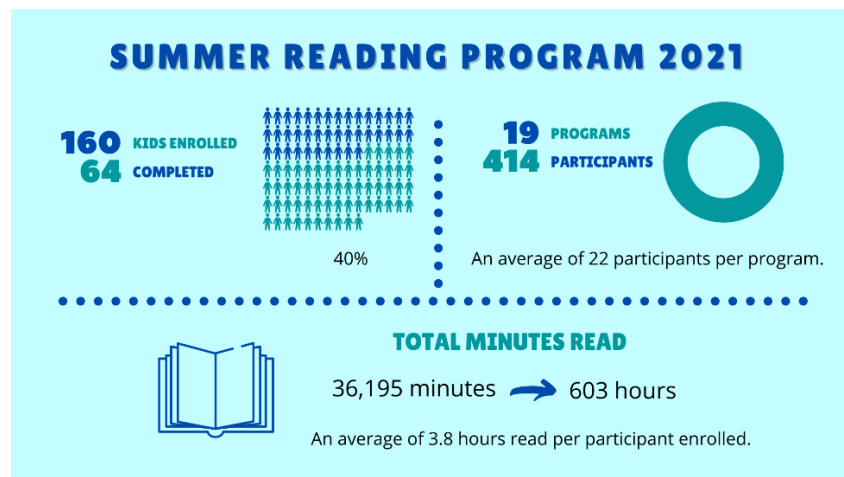
Year 2021 – 2022

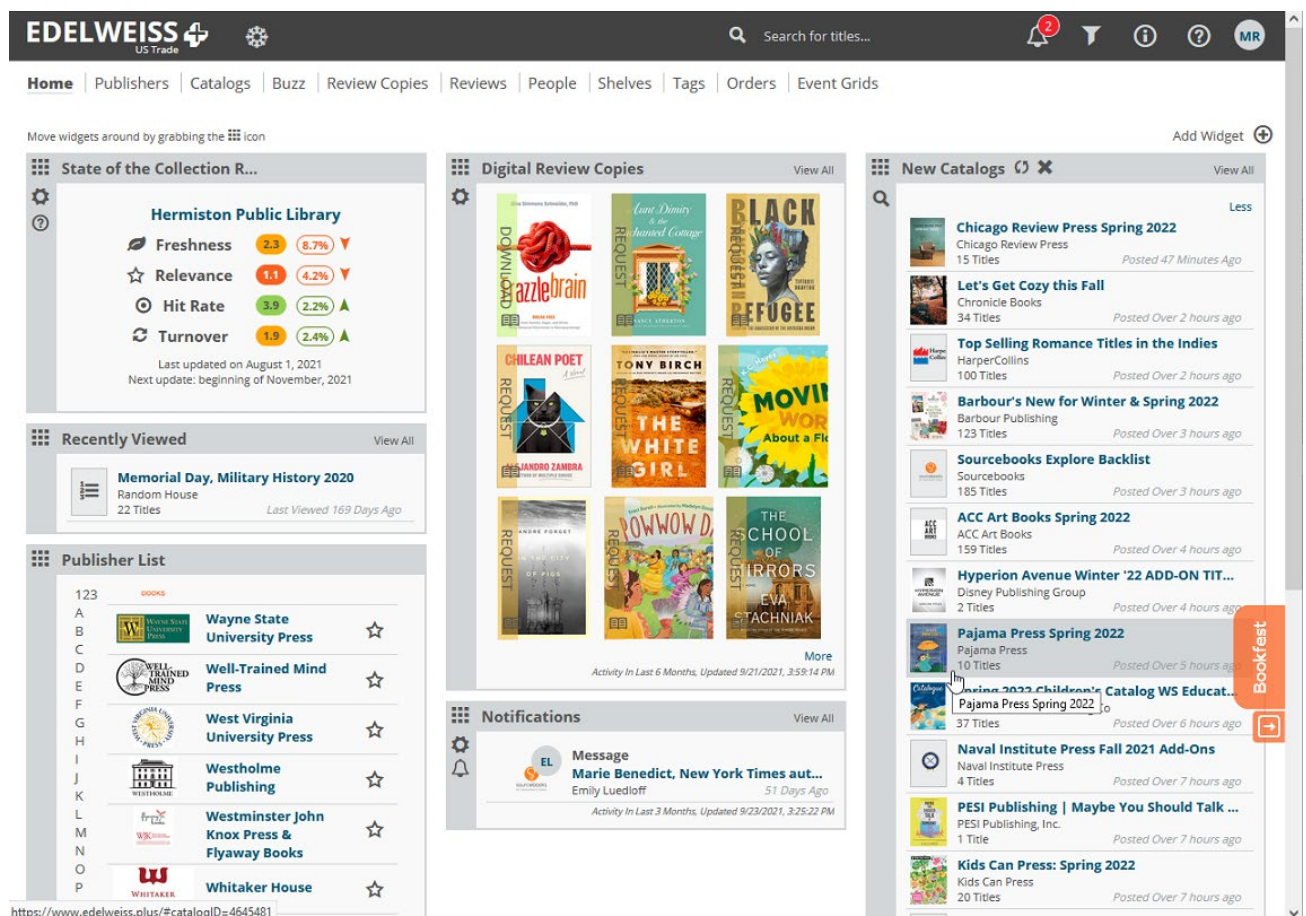

HPL has subscribed to a collection development/analysis software that interfaces with the Sage System. A scan of our holdings is conducted each quarter, a report is built that is able to pull up specifics about the collection and its use, and also compare the current information with the previous reports.
