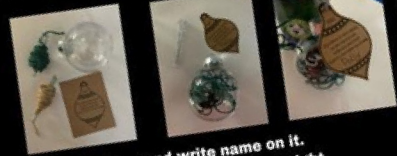

1. Put Sculpy on a flat surface.
2. Roll out until soft and smooth.
3. Cut out a 1/4 inch thick piece with a cookie cutter.
4. Use a hole punch to make a hole for hanging.
5. Bake in a preheated oven at 275 for 15 min per 1/4 in. thickness.
* DO NOT OVER BAKE. Bake until completely dry and enjoy.
