Library Vision for the Future: (Weston Public Library Vision)

Weston Public Library's staff and board support our mission to serve the greater Weston community through:

- Outstanding patron service
- Library collections that meet the needs of our community and encompass a wide range of thought and expression
- Incorporation of current information technology
- An inviting and user friendly facility
- Active involvement in the community
- A wide range of youth and adult programming
- Training of staff, board and volunteers

1. Goal: To enhance life for adults in our rural community through library programs and services.

Needs addressing: The need for adults to find adult educational and social opportunities, and to assist them with quality of life issues.

Priority: Adult Programs

Year 1 Activities

- Continue to offer 12 monthly adult book group sessions
- Host Friends of Weston Library annual meeting, featuring a guest speaker
- Host at least 2 continuing education opportunities for adults, such as photography or genealogy
- Publish and distribute monthly "Library Page," the newsletter of Weston Public Library
- Continue book delivery to housebound residents
- Seek public input regarding changes to Weston Public Library schedule of open hours, making changes to the schedule, if indicated

Year 2 Activities

- Continue all activities from Year 1
- Develop a library volunteer program

Year 3 and Beyond Activities

- Continue all activities from Year 1 and Year 2
- Host a community "Everybody Reads" type program
- Recruit new Library Board members

2. Goal: To promote literacy and a love of reading for all ages

Needs addressing: The need for citizens of all ages to recognize that reading is a huge aspect of our culture and a key life skill that benefits everyone

Priorities: Early Childhood Programs, K-12 Youth Programs, Adult Programs

Year 1 Activities

- Offer at least 25 Preschool Storytime sessions
- Offer 6 weeks of Summer Reading Program activities
- Deliver library materials to homebound residents
- Provide readers' advisory services
- Manage the library collection, including weeding and materials preservation, keeping abreast of current interests

2. Goal: To promote literacy and a love of reading for all ages (cont.)

Year 2 Activities

- Continue all Year 1 activities
- Host at least 1 after school program

Year 3 and beyond Activities

- Continue all activities from Year 1 and Year 2
- Host at least 2 after school programs

3. Goal: To create a robust environment for digital inclusion in the community

Needs addressing: The need for greater digital inclusion in our community. The Institute of Museum and Library Services defines digital inclusion as “The ability of individuals and groups to access and use information and communications technologies.”

Priority: Technology

Year 1 Activities

- Provide free access to technology
- Provide free access to digital content in the library and remotely
- Promote online subscription databases to the public, i.e. Gale databases and Library2Go, and provide trained staff assistance for their use
- Provide computer training to improve digital literacy in the community
- Partner with City of Weston to accomplish steps toward establishing broad band internet

Year 2 Activities

- Take steps toward making the Weston Public Library Historic Photo collection available online
- Continue to provide access and training listed in Year 1 activities
- Continue steps with City partnership to make available broad band in the City of Weston

Year 3 and beyond Activities

- Establish Weston Public Library Historic Photo Collection’s online presence
- Continue to provide access and training listed in Year 1 and Year 2 activities
