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WHAT GOALS DID YOU ACCOMPLISH IN FY2018-19?

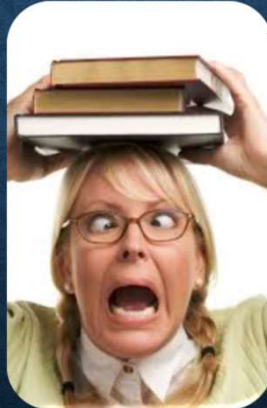
* Weeding the children's and the junior fiction sections in our library has been completed.

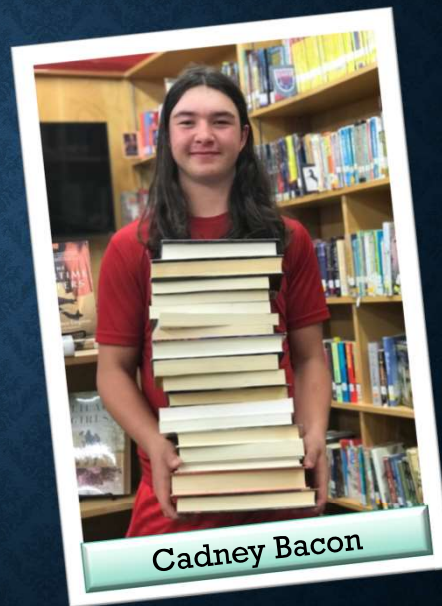
