



Cybersecurity - Tips for protecting your library data

- Know your cybersecurity policy
 - What do you need to do to safeguard data?
 - Update applications regularly
 - Change passwords
 - Two-factor authentication
 - Regular backups
- What do you need to protect?
 - Websites, ILS, Staff Computers, Patron Computers, Network, Stored Data, etc.
- What is your organization's plan in case of breach?
 - Who do you call?
 - Patrons may want to know how you are protecting their information




Sprucing Up Your Library's Interior
