

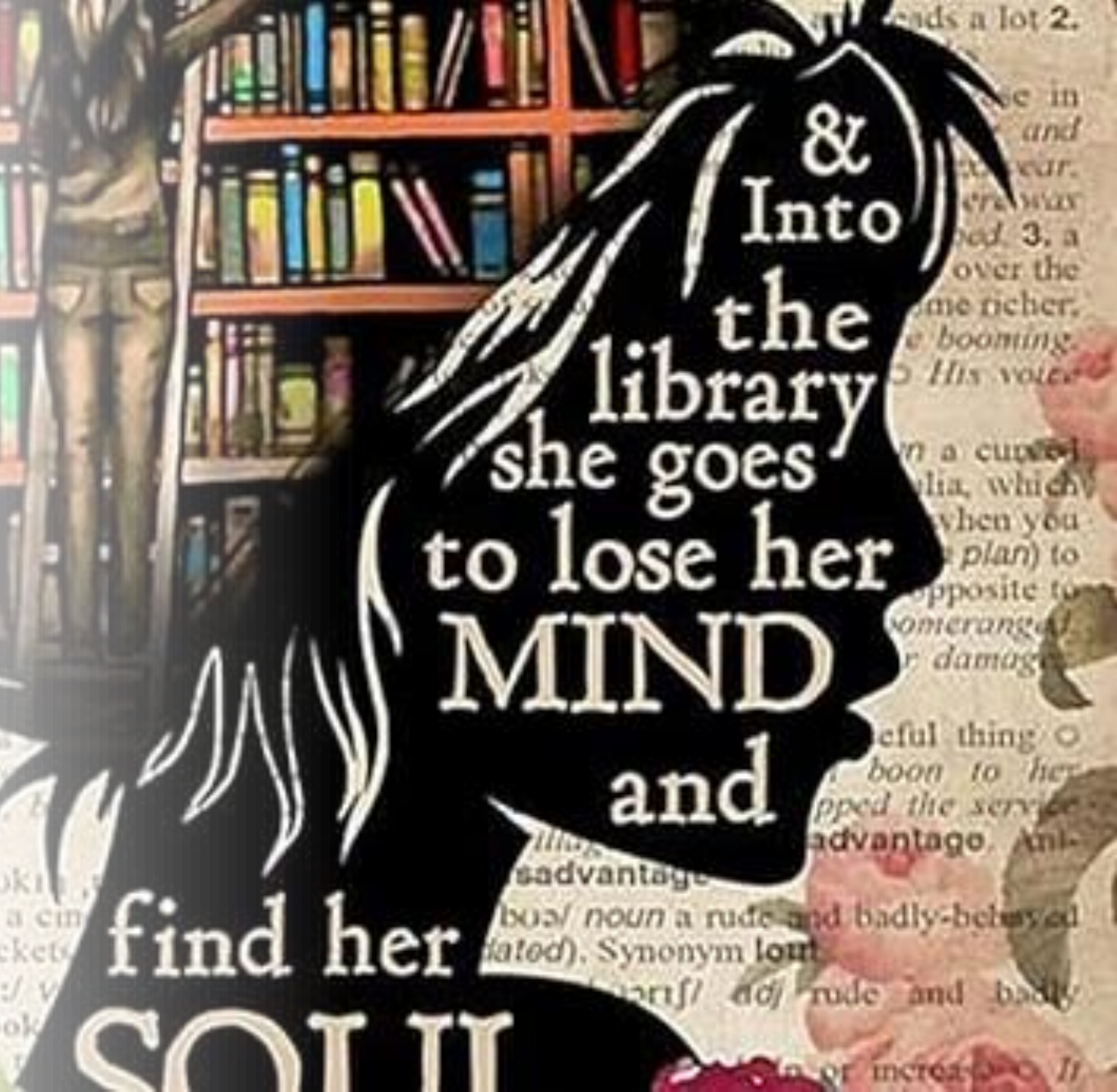

- Coordinated with parks and recs to provide shelter walls



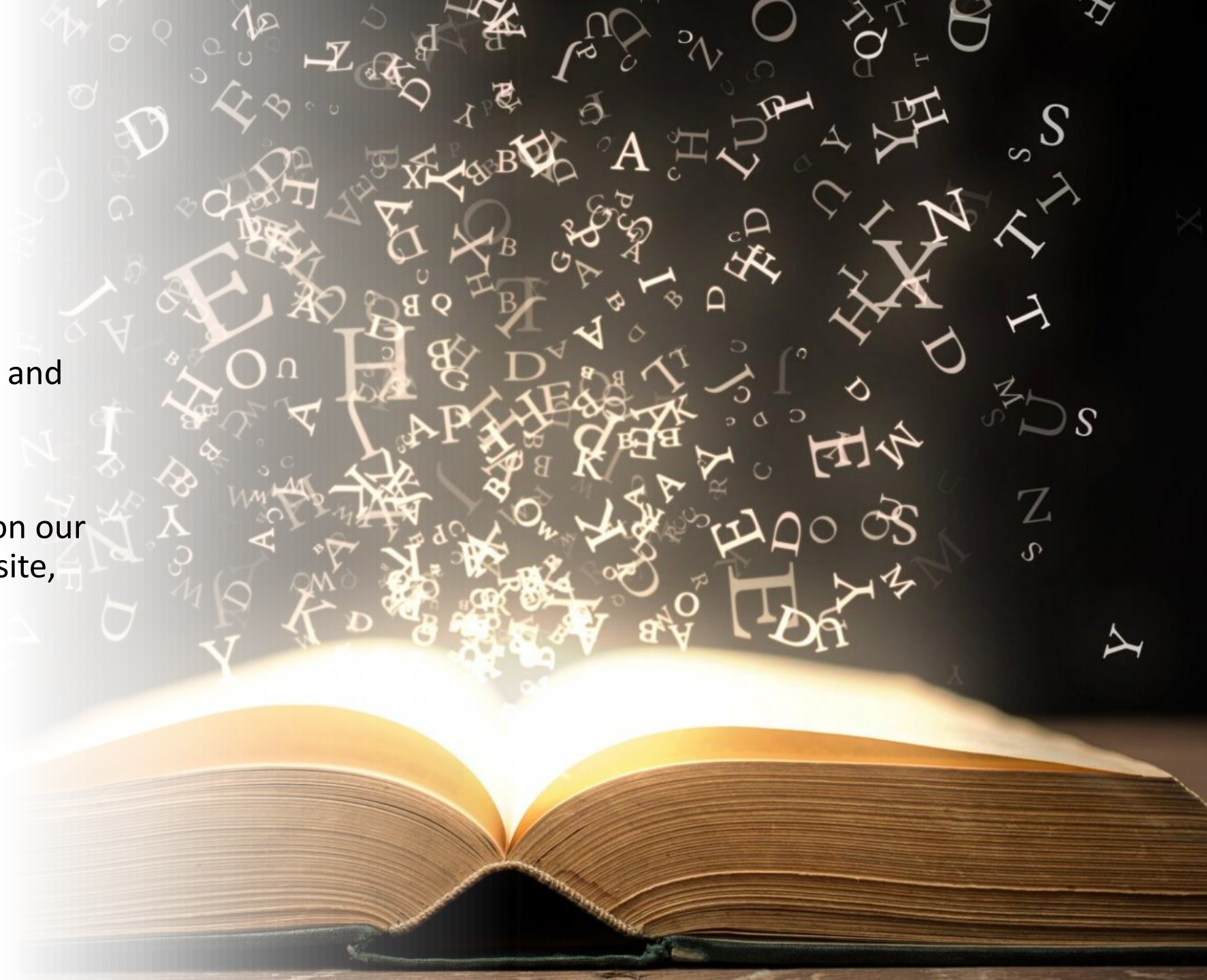
Challenges
