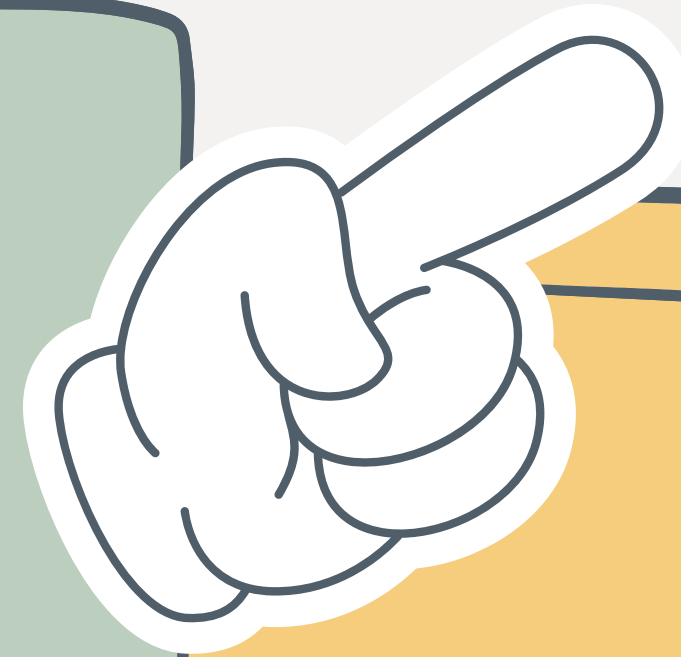

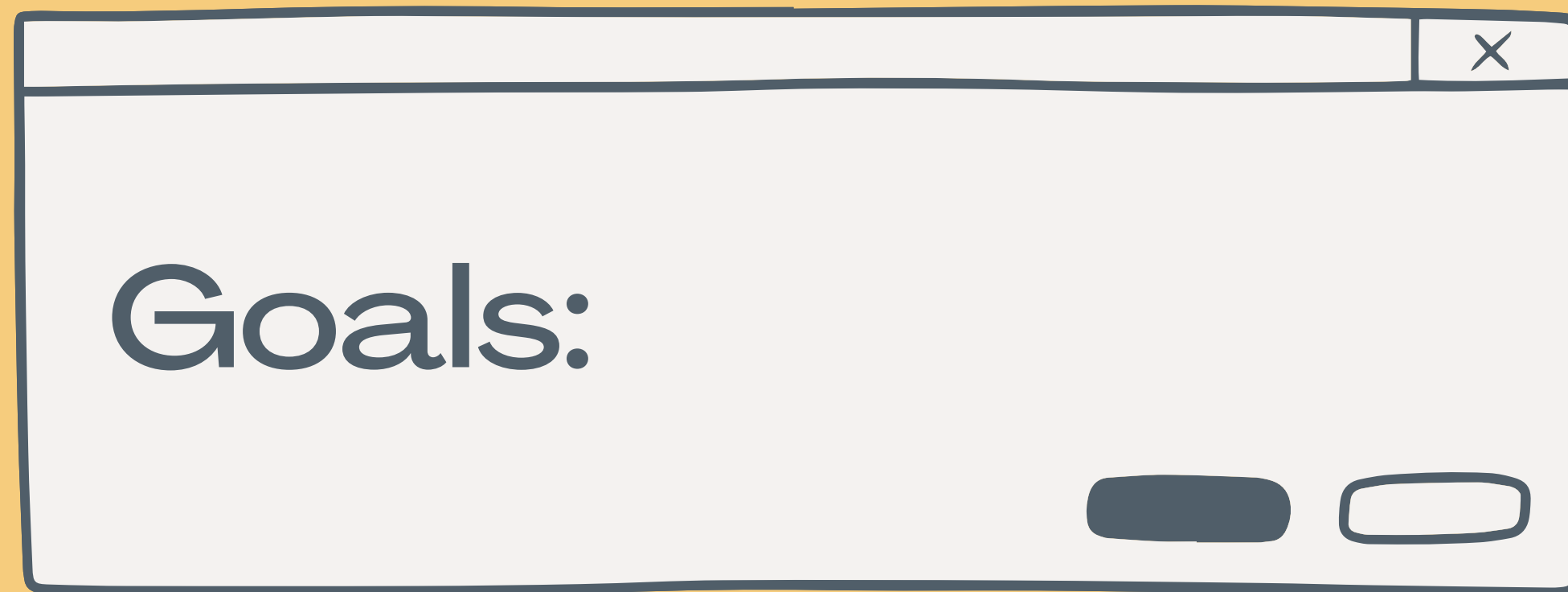


Library Vision for the Future

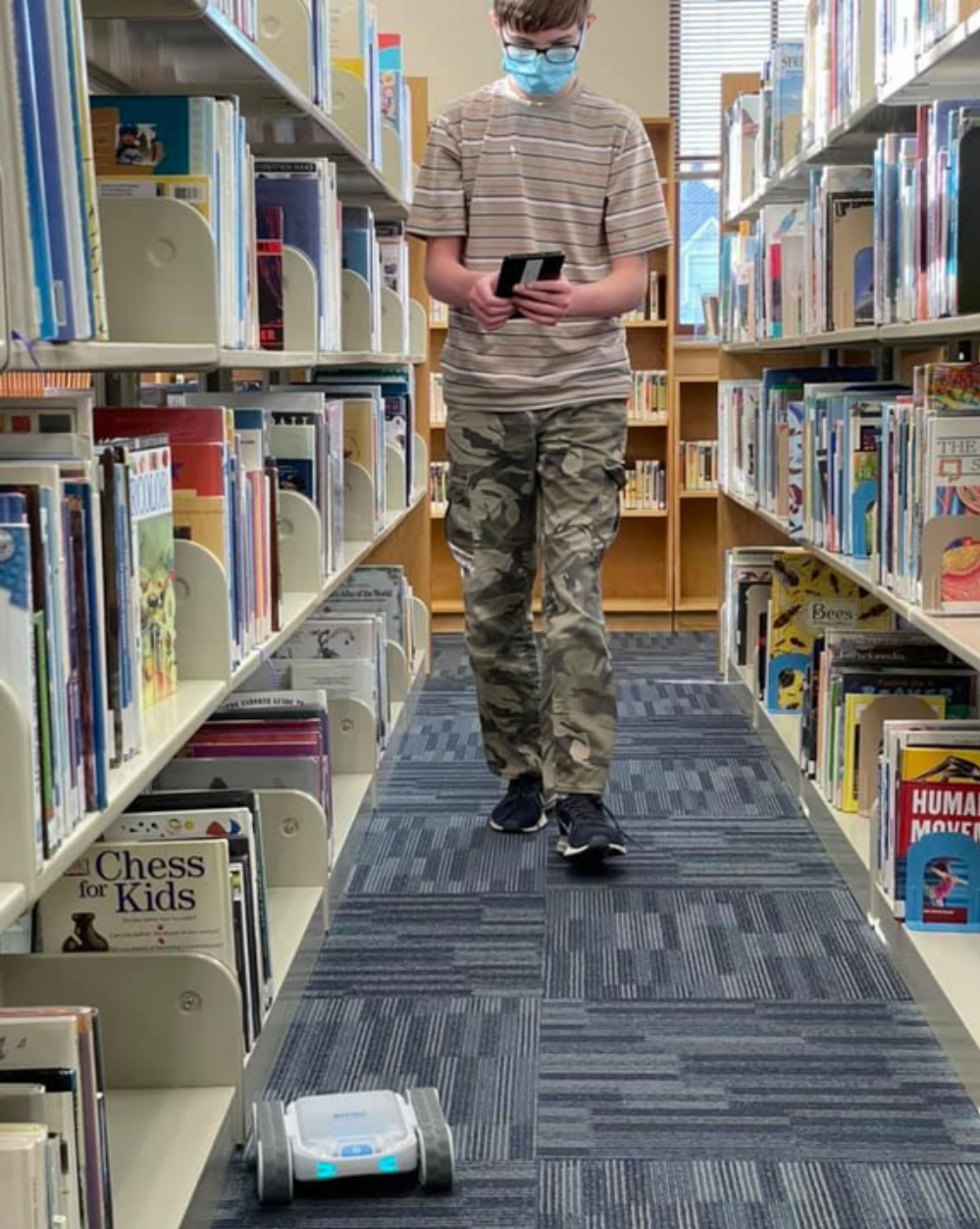

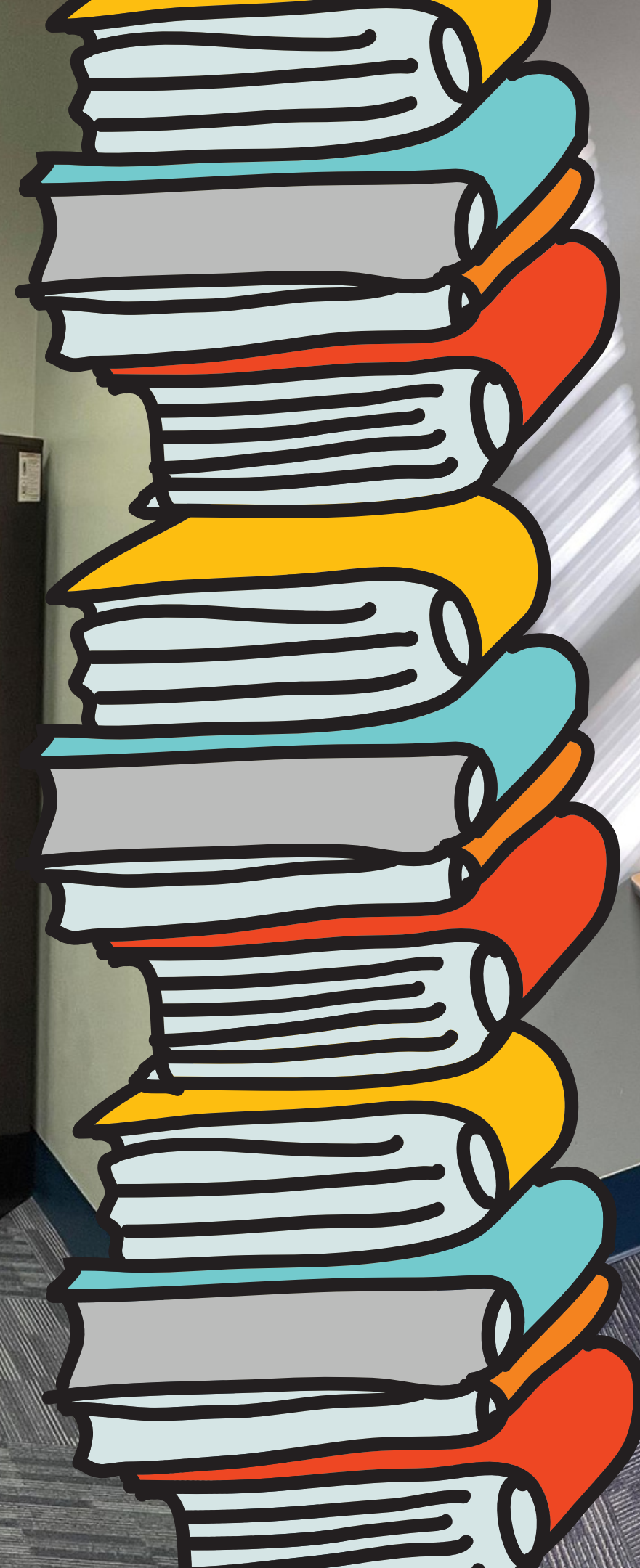
