# <u>Library Vision for the Future:</u>

It is the Adams Public Library's vision to provide appropriate resources in support of the information and recreational needs of area residents, and thereby be a center for community enrichment and lifelong learning.

#### 1. Goal: #1

programs, and bringing in speakers that could educate patrons on what offices, online tools, and parent support programs are available to them through different agencies.

### What community needs are you addressing:

There are families in our community that have been put into difficult situations due to the pandemic. With this goal, I would be adressing the needs of our community by providing information that they might not know they can reach out for. Many of our patrons are not aware of the resources we have to offer or that we can point them in the right direction. In our rural area there is also a difficulty for some to commute to classes or resource fairs, therefore sharing ways that they can attend virtually or receive free transportation would be beneficial to our community.
